Important Instructions to be followed by students:

- It will be binding upon all the students to follow the rules & regulations framed by the Principal from time to time. Irresponsible behaviour, violation of rules of the college will invite stringent punishment and even rustication from the College Rolls.
- Permanent Address, Mobile number and Email-ID entered by the student on their application form will be registered in the College admission register and if there is any change in the same it should be immediately informed to the college with an undertaking from their parents. Complete address along with telephone number of the local guardian must be clearly mentioned on the application form in Black Ink only. The college will not be responsible for misinformation.
- Principal has exclusive rights to make any addition, deletion or modification in the rules and regulations of the college and notice will be displayed to that effect from time to time. It is the responsibility of the students to take a note of such changes as and when they are displayed.
- Students must wear their identity cards around their neck while attending the college and in the premises of college.
- Two-Wheeler parking will be allowed only if the student has valid driving License
- It is compulsory for two wheeler riders to wear helmets.
- Press code is mandatory for Senior and Junior College Students. Detailed information will be given at the time of admission.
- The decision to organize any function or activity in the College will rest with the Principal.
- Nomination/Election to Students' Representative of the College and Secretary, Students' Representative Council of RTM Nagpur University will be conducted as per the rules and regulations of the University.
- Regular attendance in all classes is compulsory and it will be binding upon all the students to appear for all the examinations conducted by the college from time to time. Lack of attendance can lead to penal action from the college. Students should be present in the college only during their respective shift schedule.

Vigilance Notice:

Anti social elements in the society may misguide the students / parents regarding admission and try to extract money for the same. College admissions are absolutely transparent and strictly on merit basis. All concerned are forewarned against such malpractices. The college authorities will not take cognizance of any complaints if favours are sought from touts and agents.

Admission for Skill based courses:

Considering the employability needs the institution has decided to make certain certificate courses compulsory for specific programs. Attendance in such courses will be compulsory for students and they will have to pay {500/extra per certificate course in addition to their regular fees.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Identity Card

An identity card will be issued to the student and entry to the college premises will be granted only on producing Identity Card at the entrance gate. In case of loss of Identity Card a Duplicate I-Card will be issued on payment of Rs. 100/- with the permission of the Principal.

Attendance

75% attendance in all subjects, classes, practical is compulsory. Students will not be allowed to appear for Board / University examination if their attendance is less than 75%. For availing scholarships and other benefits extended by government agencies. 75% attendance is mandatory.

College Unit Test / Test Examination

College will conduct Unit Tests and Term Examination on the scheduled dates in accordance with the College academic diary. Attendance in these examinations is compulsory. In case students remain absent in these examinations he/she will have to furnish valid reason for absence in the examination from parents / guardians in writing to the concerned teachers and make up for the academic loss. In case, students fail to do so they will be fined as per the decision taken during Teachers'-Parents' Meet.

Cycle/Scooter Stand

Separate Two-Wheeler Stand for boys and girls are provided. Students should have License and park their two wheelers properly in locked condition on these stands only and not anywhere else. College will confiscate any unsecured two wheeler. Students must produce his/her I-Card to the guard on demand. Students should not leave the college without their vehicles. Any vehicle left in the parking lot beyond the regular college hours of the students will be confiscated as unauthorized vehicle by the college and fine will be imposed for the same. Four Wheelers are strictly prohibited for students. Honking the horns of the vehicles inside the college premises is strictly prohibited. Helmets are compulsory for all motorized two-wheeler riders. Parking inside the college premises is strictly not allowed without driving licenses and helmets.

Fee Structure, Rules and Refund

- 1) College has facilitated E-Payment gateway for all monetary transactions
- 2) First Installment of the Fees is to be paid at the time of admission to the college.
- 3) Second Installment of the Fees must be paid before 15th December.
- 4) It is mandatory to clear all dues to college before procuring the admission cards for respective Board/University examinations.
- 5) Students will have to pay University / Board Examination Fees and any additional fee charged by Board /University from time to time.
- 6) In the event of cancellation of admission, **No fees will be refunded under any circumstances.**

Important notification about fee concessions

The students availing any type of fee concession or scholarship should open a savings bank account in any nationalised bank with core banking facility and submit the bank account details and fee concession forms within 1 month from the date of the admission. Entire scholarship procedure has become online. It is the responsibility of the students to submit online application form with a hard copy to the office within 1 month from the date of admission.

- 1) EBC Concession for Economically Backward Class Students (those whose Fathers'/Parents' Income is not above Rs. 1 Lakh per annum or as per Govt. decision or those students who do not come under Backward Class community) Students who opt for Economically Backward Class Concession in fees will have to submit the application in the prescribed format within one month from the date of admission to the college along with Income Certificate of their Parents for the last financial year.
 - If students fail to submit the EBC form along with the necessary documents and those students whose EBC forms are rejected by the concerned Govt. officials, will have to **remit the full fees.** Students should submit the EBC forms separately and acknowledge the receipt of the submission of such forms and ensure the endorsement of necessary data on the I-Card by college personnel.
- 2) Girls Concession Forms are available in the College office for Junior College Students. All the girls of Junior College should submit these forms within one month from the date of admission, failing which they will not get the concession and will have to pay the full fees.
- 3) Students eligible for SC/ST/VJ/NT/OBC/SBC concessions in their fees should submit the required application form (Scholarship Form) in the office within one month from the date of admission and ensure the acknowledgement of the receipt of the form on their I-Cards.
- 4) Students eligible for Primary Teacher Concession (PTC) should submit the PTC form in the office within one month from the date of their admission and ensure acknowledgement of the receipt of the form on their I-Cards.
- 5) Secondary & Higher Secondary School Teachers' children/wards should submit the required fee concession form within one month from the date of their admission and ensure the acknowledgement of the receipt of the form on their I-Card. Only a student whose Father/Mother/Parent happens to be a High School/Middle School Teacher can avail this type of concession in the fees. Such students will have to submit a Certificate issued by the Head Master of the school where their Father/Mother/Parent happens to be a Teacher along with the concession form.
- 6) Backward Class Students who have failed only once, and are admitted to the same class are entitled for concession in fees only if the students submit the DIC (Freeship) form within one month from the date of admission.
 - 7) Under the student Welfare Scheme of R.T.M Nagpur University students from open category whose parents annual income is upto/ below Rs. one lakh are eligible for fee refund. Such students should apply for students concession within one month from the date of admission

8 Wards of Defense Personnel (Class II, III, IV) / or Ex-Servicemen can get the concession in their fees only if they submit the necessary documents along with their application form. Post Graduate Students are not eligible for EBC.

As per the government of Maharashtra rules, girl students of junior college have concession in their tuition fees, but they need to apply for girls concession within the stipulated time, failing which they will not get any concession in fees. As per the government of Maharashtra rules, tuition fee structure revised from time to time, is binding upon all the students.

For BBA and BCCA Students

- 1) PTC/EBC/Girls concessions not available.
- 2) Scholarship is granted only to students from SC and ST categories.
- 3) Fee refund for students whose parent's income is upto/ below Rs 1lakhand are from Open category are eligible for students welfare scheme by RTM Nagpur University. Request forms to be submitted within one month from date of admission to avail this facility.

Refund of Fees and Deposits

- A) Students will have to deposit full fees at the time of admission and in case of cancellation of admission **NO REFUND OF FEES WILL BE MADE.**
- B) Caution Money and Library Deposits of every student cannot be refunded till the time he/she is on the roll of our college. For claiming the refund of caution money and library deposits, students will have to put up an application certified by their parents. Refund of Caution Money & Library Deposit will be made after deducting all the pending dues against his/her name only in the Diwali Vacation of the next academic session.
- C) If any claim for refund of caution money & library deposit is not made within **three years** from the date of leaving the college, such unclaimed deposits will not be refunded and will be utilized for college development as per the decision of College Alumni/College Development Committee/CDC.

Medical Examination / Physical Test

As per the rules of RTM Nagpur University, Nagpur, every student will have to undergo Medical Examination by approved Medical Officer in the college. All the students will have to appear for the Physical Test also. Absence from both these tests will impose a fine of Rs. 100/- on the students.

Note:

In order to get the benefit of any of the scholarships mentioned above, students will have to apply for the desired scholarship within One month from the date of admission in the College and ensure the acknowledgement of the receipt. All the scholarships will be as per the Govt. rate and policy.

Rules & Regulations regarding Scholarships

- A) Students who are full time employees anywhere are not eligible for any scholarship.
- B) Scholarship will depend upon the satisfactory progress of the students. Irregularity, absence in the college examinations can lead to discontinuation of scholarship and any such decision is within the supreme powers of the concerned scholarship officer. All the beneficiaries of scholarship are instructed to open an account in any nationalized bank that has core banking facility as the scholarship will be directly transferred to their accounts from the Government.

Necessary Certificates for availing Scholarship

- 1. Photocopy of mark sheet of the last qualifying examination.
- 2. Photocopy of School/College leaving Certificate (Copy of SSC TC for 11th and 12th Standard and Copy of Std. XII TC for Part I, II and Final Year Students)
- 3. Photocopy of Caste Certificate
 - Non Creamy Layer Certificate and Income Proof Affidavit are required for the applicants belonging to OBC/SBC/NT category.
 - b) Caste Validity Certificate is required for ST Category Students.
- 4. Reference No. of Last year's Scholarship Order.
- 5. If there is any change in the District/University then certificate to that effect is required.
- 6. Gap Certificate in case of any break in the receipt of scholarship.
- 7. Scholarship forms along with all the necessary documents must be submitted within 15 days from the date of admission.
- 8. <u>All the photo copies must be attested by Special Executive Magistrate / Any Gazetted Officer.</u>
- 9. All the scholarship holders are instructed to start Saving bank A/c in their name in any Nationalized Bank for Core-Banking facility.
- 10. For Higher secondary 12th, Under graduate Second & Final year & Post graduate final year students the earlier mentioned documents should be submitted in hard copies to the scholarship section of the college within one month date of admission

Admission Process

Admission to the College is through online process. The students can download application form appended herewith. After filling up the forms online the candidates should upload the scanned copy of the required documents mentioned below and register themselves as prospective students.

Admissions will be confirmed only after the students with all original documents appear before the admission committee of the College, ensure admission and pay the fees online.

Candidates who are keen to secure admission should submit the application form Online within the stipulated time along with scanned copies of following certificates:-

- SSC & HSSC Certificates
- Aadhar card
- Mark List of Last Qualifying Examination
- School/College Leaving Certificate (ORIGINAL)
- Caste Certificate (SC/ST/NT/VJ/OBC/SBC candidates)
- If there is any gap in education then an **Affidavit** stating that candidate did not take admission in any institute after qualifying last Board / University examination must be produced.
- Income certificate attested by Govt. Gazetted Officer (for candidate availing free concession).
- For Physically challenged student certificate from Civil Surgeon certifying % of deformity . Migration and Eligibility certificate if last qualifying examination is from different board or University.

H Candidates who have passed the last qualifying examination from Board other than Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary examination or University, will have to submit migration and eligibility certificate, failing which admission will be cancelled.

SCHOLARSHIP CANNOT BE GRANTED ON DUPLICATE T.C. Once the admission is finalized the original T.C. will not be returned in any case. Hence students are advised to keep adequate photo copies of the same.

T.C will be given only after completion of the course enrolled in. In case of exceptional cases, the guardian has to personally interact with the Principal to obtain T.C for the ward before completion of the course.

STANDARD XI

- SSC from Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education is the eligibility criteria for admission to XI Std. SSC from any other board or any equivalent examination is also acceptable for admission to XI Std. Such students will have to submit a migration certificate from their parent board, eligibility certificate from Nagpur Divisional Board and their original T.C. (School Leaving Certificate) must be signed by the education officer of their Division. Admission will not be finalised unless all these documents are submitted.
- If a candidate has qualified XI Std. examination from any other college/school they will not be eligible for admission to Standard XII in this college, unless it is otherwise allowed and permitted by appropriate authorities and Govt. rules.
- Press code should be strictly followed by the students. White Shirt and Black Trousers. Dress code is compulsory for all the students
- Timing of Junior College 12.30 PM Onwards.

Rules regarding Std. XI Examination
