



या महाविद्यालयाची वाणिज्य शाखा यांच्या नेतृत्वत निर्माण झाली हे आपले काळे सर. सर १९६४ साली जी.एस. अर्थ वाणिज्य महाविद्यालयातुन एम.कॉम. झाल्या नंतर ते या महाविद्यालयात अधिव्याख्याता म्हणून रूजु झाले.

त्या वर्षी म्हणजेच १९६४ साली वाणिज्य शाखा आपल्या महाविद्यालयात सुरू झाली व वाणिज्य शाखेचे विभाग प्रमुख म्हणुन सर कार्यभार साभाळु लागले. वाणिज्य शाखेतील सर्व विषय काळे सर शिकवित व त्यांच्या नेतृत्वात वाणिज्य शाखेचा विस्तार झाला.

आर.एस.मुंडले धरमपेठ कला व वाणिज्य महाविद्यालयातील वाणिज्य शाखा हि विदर्भात शिक्षण क्षेत्रातील अव्वल शाखा म्हणून ओळखली गेली, माणसाचे माणुसपण म्हणजे काय हे काळे सरांकडुन शिकण्या सारखे आहे. त्यांनी वाणिज्य शाखा हि एक परिवार म्हणुन विकसित केली.

विज्ञान महाविद्यालयात एम.एस.सी. प्राणिशस्त्र हा पदव्युत्तर अभ्यासक्रम सुरू झाला. काळे सर १९९५ मध्ये रा.तु.म नागपूर विद्यापीठाचे पहिले प्र-कुलगुरू झाले पुढे देखिल त्यांनी रा.तु.म.नागपूर विद्यापीठत आपल्या व्यक्तीमत्वचा ठसा उमटविला हे सर्व करित असतांना विद्यापीठाच्या अनेक समित्यांवर ते राहीले परंतु त्याच बरोबर त्यांच्या शिक्षण क्षेत्रातील कामाचा विचार करून केन्द्र सरकारने त्यांची ऑल इंडिया इंस्टीटयुट ऑफ एडव्हान्स्ड स्टिडन च्या कार्यकारी समिती वर नियुक्ती केली. महाराष्ट्र सरकारने खानगी महाविद्यालयांना मिळणारे वेतनेतर अनुदान याचे सुत्र निश्चीत करण्यासाठी जी समिती नेमली त्या समितीचे ते सभासद राहिले. त्याच बरोबर त्यांच्या अध्यक्षते खाली विद्यापीठ उपकेन्द्र निर्मितीचे निकष ठरविणाऱ्या समितीचे अध्यक्ष म्हणुन महाराष्ट्र शासनाने त्यांची नियुक्ती केली. विद्यापीठात नवनवीन अभ्याक्रम निर्माण करण्या साठी महाराष्ट्र शासनाने जी समिती नेमली त्याचे ते सभासद होते.

21 Sept 2019

Vermicomposting activity conducted by Shrushti Environmental Club





Vermicomposting is a process in which culture of earthworms is being introduced in alternate layers of soil, cow dung and bio-degradable waste materials like waste papers vegetables & other kitchen wastes. This process Involves decompostion of biodegradable wastes by earth worms the process is as follows-1-selection of four medium sized cement tanks.

- 2-Number tanks as 1,2,3 & 4.
- 3-Introduce moist soil at the bottom of tank 1.add a layer of moist cow dung on it.
- 4-Introduce a layer of dry leaves, vegetable wastes on it.
- 5-Again add a layer of moist soil first and then of moist soil and then a cow dung on it.
- 6-Now introduce a culture of 1kg earhworms and then keep on layerings of soil, cow dung & dry leaves, vegetable wastes on it for four tto five times.
- 7-Now put a very fine lid on it.
- 8-Keep the set up in moist condition for 20 days.
- 9-After 20 days we will get a well decomposed black manure of it.
- 10-Filter manure to remove worms.
- 11-Now in tank -2 follow the same process.
- 12-We may keep collected biodegradable wastes in tank 3 & 4 for further cultures.
- 13-Now culture in tank-1 is ready as a compost for plants.
- 14-It is having high nutritional value for crop plants too.
- 15-Hence earhworms are said to be good friends of farmers.

overwhelms the world's ability to deal with them.

The reality of plastic in India is as follows as per the image shown above. Like much of the world, India is struggling to dispose its growing quantities of plastic waste given how ubiquitous it has become — from our tooth brushes to debit cards. India generates close to 26,000 tonnes of plastic a day, according to a CPCB estimate from 2012. Worse, a little over 10,000 tonnes a day of plastic waste remains uncollected.

- Our plastic consumption is increasing.
- E-commerce companies too have come under fire for excess use of plastic packaging. "Online companies should be held responsible for the plastic waste they generate.
- Sikkim was a pioneer in banning plastic bags as far back as 1998. Others followed, and so far, around 22 states and UTs have bans in place, says Nigam. "But merely announcing a ban will not solve the problem of plastic disposal.
- Plastic users should be provided with feasible alternatives, which are not costly and made aware of these options
- Time will come when there will be plastic everywhere our food, Clothes, water and even our bodies.
- It's time to act beyond!!!
- Some law to be made to ensure that producers and brand owners will be responsible for waste collection from their products
- Role and responsibility of producers in plastic waste management
